District 3, summary April 2020

This is the second year of the districtwide diversity initiative in District 3 that prioritizes 25% of seats for students who are lower performing and eligible for free or reduced price lunch. 17 of the 19 schools in the district participate, with the exception of Anderson and Special Music School. The Center school joined the diversity plan for the first time in 2020.

This year, ~1,790 students applied to a District 3 middle school, a decrease from ~ 1,900 last year.

- 1460 students received an offer to a District 3 middle school, a slight decrease from 1471 last year.
- 63% of students who matched to a D3 choice on their application received their top choice, and 91% received one of their top three choices. This is compared to 58% and 87%, respectively, in 2019.

In Year 2, we see similar results as in the pilot year.

- 8 of the 17 schools are within 10 percentage points of 25%, including the Center School which is participating for the first time this year.
- Last year, 7 schools also fell within this range and in 2018 only two schools were within this range.
- There are 78 students who received an offer to a school not listed on their application. This is a decrease from 92 students last year.
